Our Industrial Equipment & Facility Manager duties will include

- Install, adjust and repair production equipment and special purpose machines as assigned
- Operate a variety of hand and power tools to repair, grease, weld, cut, change parts and complete tasks as assigned
- Test malfunctioning machinery, determine repairs and discuss with head mechanic for approval and repair as needed
- Install equipment and electrical components and test to ensure proper functioning
- Dismantle equipment to gain access to and remove defective parts using hoists, cranes, hand tools and power tools
- Lubricate and clean parts and equipment to ensure proper operation
- Adjusts, repairs, or replaces functional parts of devices and control instruments
- Record and maintain repair records on all equipment, and ensure that all safety guidelines are followed within all aspects of the job

- Assist with lifting moderately heavy objects, which could be up to 100 lbs
- Perform general building and facility maintenance
